- V. **5th Grade Science Curriculum – Belinda Cernick, Tom Rick, Melissa Schultz, and Barb Sparish**

- VII. **Elementary PBIS – Chris Christofferson and Amanda Brown**
The teachers presented what PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) is and what it looks like at the elementary school. PBIS focuses on the positive and teaching students the correct behavior. Positive behavior is acknowledged through the use of “Warrior Way” cards. The goal for Tier 1 is that 80% of the students will respond to the behavioral expectations. Tier 2 offers additional support to a targeted group of students. The elementary schools have been trained in Tier 1 and are implementing Tier 2. Training is now being offered for Tier 2 and are moving forward with Tier 2 implementation.
- VIII. **Marketing Education Task Force Update – Curt Pacholke, Josh Tomesh, Kelly Orr, Janette Walters, Bert Richard, and Barb Sparish**
The task force has met two times to discuss the potential of developing a marketing program. The next steps are to clearly define what Academic Career Planning (ACP) will look at the Rice Lake Area School District and how marketing education fits into that.
