

WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR COURSE - BLENDED LEARNING

Training to become a Water Safety Instructor will be offered at the the Rice Lake Pool. This is a Blended Learning course requiring Online & Swim Skills Sessions. Candidates must pass the prerequisite swim skills listed below to enroll.

PREREQUISITES -

Swimming strokes:

Front Crawl - 25 yds, Back Crawl - 25 yds, Elementary Backstroke - 25 yds,

Breaststroke - 25 yds, Sidestroke - 25 yds, Butterfly 15 yds

Maintain back position Floating or sculling in Deep Water for 1 minutes

Tread water for 1 minute

REGISTRATION -

Once prerequisite skills are passed the candidate will receive an email with course details from the Instructor Trainer - Bambi Forcey

You must register for Blended Online portion at the link provided in the email.

FEES -

ONLINE FEE - \$35 by Credit Card to Red Cross

Registration fee for online access is to be paid with a credit card by participant at the time of registration.

COURSE FEE - \$150.00 to Rice Lake Pool

There is a fee for the Course to be paid to the Rice Lake Pool - \$150.00

Course fee must be paid by the 3rd skills sessions scheduled.
