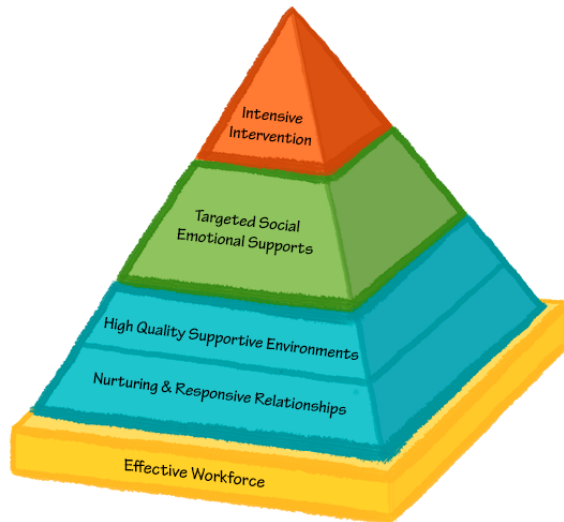


PYRAMID MODEL:

WHAT IS THE PYRAMID MODEL?

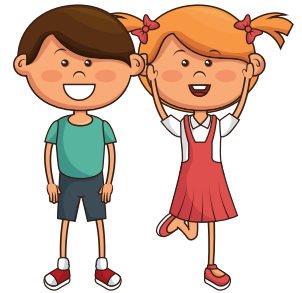
- Designing engaging classrooms
