

Reading Assessments

PALS (Phonological Awareness Literacy Screening)

The essential screening, diagnostic, and progress monitoring tool for measuring the fundamental components of literacy. This is given to all K-2 students and is teacher administered.

STAR Reading Assessment

Given to all 2nd - 4th grade students This is a computer based program that provides data on reading skills and helps to set goals for reading.

Benchmark Assessment

Given to all first through fourth grade students at least once per year and more often as needed. Gives classroom teachers information on student accuracy, comprehension and use of reading strategies.

DRA (Developmental Reading Assessment)

Given by Reading Interventionists when more detailed information about student reading is deemed necessary

Aimsweb Progress Monitoring

1 minute probes, given by Reading Interventionists weekly to all students participating in reading interventions. These probes measure the effectiveness of interventions.
